

BAND BOOSTER MEETING FROM AUGUST 29, 2017

Band Booster President, Dana Robertson, called the meeting to order.

The Treasurer's Report was on the Weebly for review, and the Minutes were accepted.

Dana said our profit from the merchandise tent at the Tomato Festival was around \$420, and they sold \$270 of Raffle tickets. Also we sold over \$1000 of merchandise at Open House.

Dana also stressed that we only sell donuts at the gates! We can not conflict with concession sales, so please only sell at the gates.

Also, it was again discussed that we will sell donuts for \$8 a dozen. We had 12 dozen not sold at the first home game. Also, from now on we will freeze any leftover donuts so we can reuse them for band food.

The lawn mower raffle on Friday night didn't sell very well. We just have to keep trying.

The next fundraiser will be with Brittaney Chester and her Premiere Jewelry. She will be coming in on the day of the Preview Show. We will check on a time.

Trivette went over the Weebly website. He went over the syllabus, grading, and necessary items for concert band. Trivette generally has items the students may need, and the students can purchase them from Trivette.

Trivette also stressed that HE WILL NOT TAKE LATE WORK! This is so very important!

The school will be doing "Trunk or Treat" on Oct. 31st. However, the concert band performance will not be on Halloween. The concert will be on Nov. 2.

This year we will not be participating in the Salisbury Holiday Caravan (Christmas Parade) because we will be participating in the Mooresville Parade. We plan to alternate each year.

As for the Fruit Sale, we may decide to sell North Carolina apples. We do need the extra income in the month of October. We need to determine if apples would be feasible for us or if we need to look for something else. We need someone to go to Father & Son to see if we can get info.

Dana will be signing out Raffle tickets tonight.

Mandy Benware said she spoke with Randall Barger at the fair about their vendor spots. They are \$275 each.

Cindy Nooner asked for everyone present to sell at least three Preview Show Program ads. She also passed out information for Student Ads.
