

BAND BOOSTER MEETING MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 25, 2016

Band Booster President, Dana Robertson, called the meeting to order.

The Minutes and the Treasurer's Report were both online for review.

Dana noted that the Disney payment for 10/28 would be due Friday, and 54 people are going.

Dana said merchandise sales have been good, but we still have a lot to do to start clearing profit. She mentioned that it would be a good time to sell sweatpants at the Fall Concert on Thursday, 10/27.

Our Fruit Sale ends this Friday, 10/28. Dana Robertson, Susan Files, and Mandy Benware agreed to help Trivette count and record the Fruit Sale information.

All Fruit Sale money is due Friday, 10/28. Also All-District money is due Friday.

Trivette said there will be no band rehearsal on Thursday, 10/27, and no school on Monday, 10/31. Also from now on, students will not be required to wear shorts for practice. They will need either their blue or black shirt or hoodie.
